## **Airport Transfers**

The meeting venue is a 41-minute drive from the airport. Airport transfers will be provided by the hotel shuttle for all international delegates.

All self-sponsored delegates are requested to share their travel itineraries to enable the scheduling of the transfers. For departure, participants are advised to inform the Hotel Reception Desk to confirm the best time to leave for the airport. Private cars & taxis may be hired at the delegate's cost. #### **Flight Re-Confirmations**

#### Per Diem
